- A statement of the objectives as well as a detailed description of the proposed project.
- An explanation of how the proposed project will fit in with your long-term academic goals.

_____ Organization description (if you propose to work with a specific organization)

_____ Travel itinerary and schedule

_____ Budget

_____ Application form – Complete this form online.

_____ An Official transcript

_____ Two References - It is the applicant's responsibility to give the reference form to the recommenders, along with a copy of the project proposal. (The form should be given far enough in advance so the recommenders can meet the deadline.) The recommenders may return the letter to the student (in a sealed, signed envelope) or send it directly to the Kellogg Institute.
