What can I do as a doctoral student affiliated with the Kellogg Institute?

- » **Reach out to our Kellogg Faculty Fellows**, the more than 130 Notre Dame [scholars](https://kellogg.nd.edu/people/kellogg-faculty) (kellogg.nd.edu/people/kellogg-faculty) whose research is at the core of the institute's work.
- » **Participate in Kellogg's unique research opportunities.** Collaborate with Kellogg scholars in our faculty-led [Policy and Practice Research Labs](https://kellogg.nd.edu/labs) (kellogg.nd.edu/labs), a major effort that supports rigorous scholarship intended to have a tangible impact on policy outcomes and advance interdisciplinary inquiry on issues related to global democracy.



- » **Earn recognition for your work.** Doctoral Student Affiliates are eligible to compete for the annual [Kellogg Institute Award for Outstanding Doctoral Student Contributions](#), which recognizes a graduate student for exceptional contributions to the intellectual life of the Institute and carries a monetary prize of \$500.
