ADVISOR APPROVAL FORM Latin American Studies Program

Students may replace one of their five required content courses with an essay on a topic related to Latin America. Choosing this option requires registering for the "Area Studies Essay: Latin American Course" (AL 495), for which you need approval from the LASP office

Students who choose this option must find a faculty advisor early in the fall semester (or during the junior year). In order to register for AL 495 students must have the faculty advisor sign an "Advisor Approval Form" and submit it to the LASP office in advance of the third week of classes.

Students should meet with their advisor regularly over the course of the semester, and the advisor will assign the final grade for the essay and the course. Final essays are due in the office no later than the first day of finals week, and will not be accepted without a "Final Grade Form" completed and signed by the advisor.
